





Seneca Lake Duck Hunters Association 23rd Annual Cal Dewitt Rabbit Hunt Application Sunday, January 29, 2023

Rabbit Hunt Rules & Regulations

- 1) The event will be known as the Cal Dewitt Memorial Rabbit Hunt, and will be held on all New York State lands on January 29, 2023. Entry fee shall be \$10.00 per participant over the age of 16, Entry fees for hunters 16 and under will be waived. Hunt applications and entry fees MUST be delivered (or received by mail) to the Seneca Lake Duck Hunters Club no later than 6:00PM on the evening prior to the Hunt. There will be no exceptions made.
- 2) The Rules and Regulations of the N.Y.S. Department of Environmental Conservation will govern the event.
- 3) Rabbits, Squirrels or Grouse from any New York State lands are eligible, and must be taken only on the day of the hunt and prior to the absolute weigh-in deadline of 3:00PM on Sunday.
- 4) Hours of operation for official weigh-in at the Club are from 11:00am to 3:00PM on Sunday. There will be no exceptions.
- 5) Seneca Lake Duck Hunters Association, Inc., and/or the Rabbit Hunt Committee will render final judgment regarding the legality of any animal being entered.
- 6) One monetary prize per contestant.
- 7) Once an animal is weighed and/or entered in the Hunt, it will become property of the Seneca Lake Duck Hunters Association, Inc. All winning entries may be cut and examined for foreign matter. Any animal found containing foreign matter will be disqualified, and the entrant will be barred from future participation in the Hunt.
- 8) The Seneca Lake Duck Hunters Association, Inc. appreciates and accepts donations of animals for the Annual Game Dinner
- 9) Seneca Lake Duck Hunters Association, Inc., the Rabbit Hunt Committee, and/or Sponsors of the Hunt will not be held liable for any accident or injury sustained during this event.
- 10) Cash Prizes will be awarded immediately following the weigh-in deadline of 3:00PM Sunday. Total prize money will be determined by the number of entrants, minus expenses: Rabbit, 1st -3rd place; Squirrel, 1st -3rd place and Grouse, 1st place only.
- 11) Each individual entrant may weigh in any number of Rabbit or Grouse and up to 2 Squirrel.
- 12) Dependent upon circumstances and at the discretion of Seneca Lake Duck Hunters Association, Inc and/or the Rabbit Hunt Committee, entrants may be required to present photo ID at weigh-in.
